Here are some considerations you should make before moving to an electronic forms solution.

1 DETERMINE YOUR EXISTING COSTS FOR USING PAPER

Evaluate and document your cost of doing paper-based business. Include costs associated with both time and money, such as paper, form design, print fees, and the time it takes staff to complete the manual paper process, scanning, etc.

2 EFORMS BRING PATIENTS AND TECHNOLOGY TOGETHER

3 CREATE A FORMS COMMITTEE

Your committee should include representation from all departments within your hospital where forms are used.

4 INVENTORY & ANALYZE EXISTING FORMS

Review every form in use to eliminate multiples and ensure content is correct. As each form is approved, give it an ID number or name, log the form in inventory and initiate version control.

5 BE PREPARED TO PRESENT PHYSICAL FORMS TO PATIENTS

Depending on the devices you use, especially for signature, your patient may not be able to view the digital form in its entirety. Options for presenting forms electronically include a secondary monitor or full size tablet. Otherwise, have laminated copies of forms available for review.

6 KNOW THE TYPES OF EFORMS SOLUTIONS IN THE MARKET

Print & Go: Vendors provide blank forms that can be printed as needed or ordered in bulk. The vendor can also create new forms and modifications for a fee.

Print-To-Scan: Vendors merge patient data with a form that can be printed with barcodes. End-users generate forms on demand or the process can be automated.

Full-Service: These vendors offer a solution for ALL your printed and interactive forms, production services, APIs, and ongoing eForms maintenance.
